Candidate(s) will be responsible for performing venipunctures and skin punctures competently and expediently. Responsible for performing and observing chemical tests on patient specimens and correctly recording all results. Performing quality control procedures and maintaining records on these procedures. Responsible for setting up, clearing and maintaining laboratory equipment. Responsible for reporting test results to physicians and other clinical providers. Scheduled to work 40 hours per week with overtime as required.

Performs medical laboratory tests, procedures, experiments, and analyses to provide data for diagnosis, treatment, and prevention of disease: conducts chemical analyses of body fluids, such as blood, urine, and spinal fluid, to determine presence of normal and abnormal components. Studies blood cells, their numbers, and morphology, using microscopic technique. Prepare cultures and other required duties in microbiology.

Access, manage and update patient medical records through Hospital Electronic Medical Record Information System. Identifies patients, collects, labels, transports and stores all lab specimens according to established policies. Accurately and reproducibly conducts chemical analyses of body fluids such as blood, urine, and spinal fluid, to determine presence of normal and abnormal components. Calls panic values per established policy. Correlates and interprets test results and enters findings in computer. Maintains appropriate inventory of supplies. Performs quality control studies to ensure accuracy of clinical data. Performs routine preventative maintenance on assigned instruments and equipment according to established schedule and procedure. Verifies instrument functioning by checking and calibrating specific lab instruments and documents data. Records on instrument logs any repairs, replacement, and maintenance needed
